- These rules have been instituted to provide a safer learning environment for all of our children.

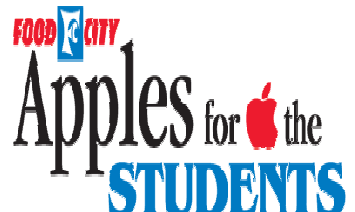


Food City Apples for the Students kicks off again
